2019 ICON WRITING WORKSHOP

In January, you will have the unique opportunity to participate in a 6-day icon writing workshop with master iconographer, Dmitri Andreyev, in beautiful Laguna Beach, CA.



The 6-day intensive workshop involves the study of the Byzantine-Russian tradition of icon-writing. This multilayered process will be presented along with the theological meaning of each step and the rich symbolic associations of the natural materials used. We will be writing the icon of St. Michael the Archangel shown above.

Dmitri is from the Prosopon School of Iconography, founded by his father Vladislav Andreyev. He has preserved the ancient Russian-Byzantine tradition of iconography using only natural materials, including ground pigments and egg tempura.
