Next summer we are privileged to have Vladislav Andrejev, the founder of the Prosopon School of Iconology and his son Dmitri Andreyev to mentor our workshop to be held at All Saints Episcopal Church. This continues a long series of Prosopon workshops in Omaha, several of which were held at All Saints between 2002 - 2005. It seems to be particularly fitting that this workshop will be held this year at All Saints, and we are deeply grateful for All Saints' hospitality.



The workshop will consist of lectures on the theology, theory and the technical execution of iconography. In the workshop each participant will write an icon on a wood panel using the traditional egg tempera medium and other technical procedures such as gold leaf application, burnishing and floating. The process unfolds over six days, mirroring the six days of creation, and includes a lot of one on one instruction. All materials are provided for the participants as well as daily lunches. Some of the out-oftown participants will be staying at the retreat center which will greatly assist their participation in the intense week.

The method of the school is distinct in that the succession of steps of icon writing are associated with the liturgical service of the services of the church, thus making the icon process sacramental. The layering method produces a luminosity that characterized the 14th Century Russian School.



The participants strive for the highest level of artistic accomplishment, nevertheless the focus of the icon writer is on personal spiritual discipline

and growth within the guidelines of the Orthodox Church according to

which icons are the "Gospel in light and color." Nevertheless, the Prosopon School welcomes inquiring students from all traditions.
