As in 15th -16th Century Russia, students will create icons using ancient techniques and natural materials rich with symbolic meaning: birch wood boards prepared with gesso, made from chalk and glue, finely ground clay, 23K gold leaf, and ground mineral pigments in an emulsion made from egg yolk and white wine.

The theology of the icon will also be equally emphasized, as each step has a symbolic meaning.

Previous artistic experience is not necessary since icon "writing" is as much a contemplative form of prayer as an artistic discipline. The workshop will consist of three full day sessions, during which each student will contemplate an icon. New and intermediate students will be provided with step by step instructions and all necessary materials. Students who have attended previous workshops and advanced students will need to bring icons they want to complete and their own supplies.

Dmitri Andreyev, iconographer, and son of school founder, Vladislav Andrejev, has conducted workshops throughout America and Canada. You can find more information about Prosopon School of Iconology at www.prosoponschool.org
